

BENEFITS OF A STATE-CERTIFIED TAP PROGRAM

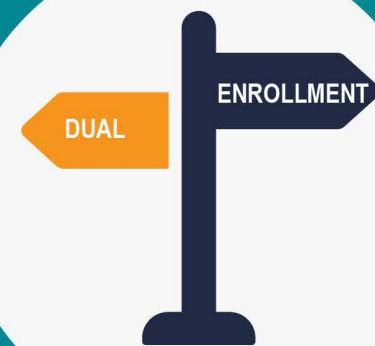
Work-Based Learning (WBL)

Pre-Apprentices can participate and earn WBL credits in structured on-the-job learning that allows them to practice what they learn in the classroom, preparing them so be successful.



Dual Enrollment Opportunities

Allows students to get closer to 57-60 credit hours and an early start on college.



TAP Coursework

Coursework standards aligned to the TEAM Rubric--Tennessee's teacher evaluation model--and many of these skills transfer to postsecondary education.



Experienced Mentorship
