Program Design

Course Location:

Flexible learning location, which may be on-campus or off-campus depending on individual apprentice's needs.

Program Format:

Online or Hybrid: These classes can be fully online with no campus requirement, or a combination of online and on campus.

Timing for Courses:

Blended: These classes are a combination of asynchronous and synchronous. Classes have specific meeting days/times during the term, but will allow for flexibility to meet apprentice's needs.

Program Duration: 21 months

Total Credit Hours: 57-59 hours

Total Clinical Experience Hours: Varies
