Program Design

Course Location:

Course locations are online and face to face depending on the course. Face to face courses will be offered at times that work for the working learner's schedule.

Program Format:

Hybrid: These classes are a combination of online and on campus.

Timing for Courses:

Blended: These classes are a combination of asynchronous and synchronous. Classes have specific meeting days/times during the term — but do not require synchronous instruction every week. In some cases, blended classes will mostly meet online but will also have some face-to-face classes. Days/times are listed in the class schedule.

Program Design

Course Location:

The number of hybrid or in person meetings vary by semester and course. Currently, coursework includes in-person, online, and remote synchronous learning.

Program Format:

Hybrid: These classes are a combination of online and on campus.

Timing for Courses:

Blended: These classes are a combination of asynchronous and synchronous. Classes have specific meeting days/times during the term — but do not require synchronous instruction every week. In some cases, blended classes will mostly meet online but will also have some face-to-face classes. Days/times are listed in the class schedule.

Program Design

Program Format:

Online: These modules are fully online with no campus requirement.

Timing for Courses:

Asynchronous: These modules are fully online the entire term with no set class meeting days/times. There are no days/times listed in the course schedule, and they have asynchronous instruction throughout the entirety of the program. Some face-to-face sessions will be scheduled to address additional topics outside the course modules.
